The Year 6 SAT results are as follows:

What next?

Our results in 2015 were mixed. Compared to 2014 there was a big improvement in Grammar, Spelling and Punctuation, whilst scores for Reading dipped. Children's progress in maths stayed the same and writing remained a strength.

The School Development Plan focuses on improvements in 4 key areas. The targets each year are set based on both results from national tests and an evaluation of what is happening in the school now. All of our staff will work together in order to make improvements. Your involvement in working with your child in the areas below, where you can, would be very beneficial.

Targets:

1. Our children's attitudes to learning:
 - Improving their confidence to have a go at finding answers on their own
 - Improving their 'stickability' so that they don't give up when they face challenges
2. Maths:
 - Improving what children know about numbers (mathematical fluency)
 - Improving our children's ability to choose what maths to use so that they can answer questions and find solutions or spot patterns
3. Reading:
 - Improving our children's understanding of what they read, what characters might think or why texts are written or set out in a certain way.
 - Inspiring our children to be really enthusiastic about reading
4. Assessment:
 - Expecting our children to be responsible and follow the improvement advice they have been given by their teacher
 - Making sure that all teachers know exactly which step every child needs to take next and that they set work that is the right level of difficulty for the children so that they can practise and improve
